AAPI Data and APIA Vote

The 2024 AAPI Voter Survey was conducted between September 3-9, 2024 by NORC. Survey respondents are Asian Americans, Native Hawaiians, and Pacific Islanders 18 years of age or older, with oversamples of citizens and registered voters. The data have been weighted by ethnicity, education, Census Region, age by gender, ethnicity by gender, and ethnicity by nativity. More details can be found in the Methodology section at the bottom of this document.

Methodology

The *2024 AAPI Voter Survey from AAPI Data and APIA Vote* was conducted between September 3-9, 2024 by NORC using NORC's Amplify AAPI® Panel for the sample source. The survey was offered in English, Chinese dialects of Mandarin and Cantonese, Vietnamese, and Korean and was administered in two modes depending on the preference of the respondent provided during panel recruitments: 1) self-administered by the respondent online via the Web; or 2) administered over the telephone by a live interviewer. The surveys with a live interviewer were only conducted in English.

Survey respondents are Asian American voters, Native Hawaiians, and Pacific Islanders 18 years of age or older, with oversamples of citizens and registered voters. The data have been weighted by ethnicity, education, Census Region, age by gender, ethnicity by gender, and ethnicity by nativity.

The total number of AAPI adults surveyed was 1,123 and the overall margin of error is +/- 4.7 percent.
