# **Built on Amplify AAPI**

### LARGEST, MOST REPRESENTATIVE public opinion panel of AANHPIs

- Interviews in English and Asian languages with largest need: Mandarin, Cantonese, Korean, and Vietnamese
- Designed to be representative of the AANHPI U.S. household population, including all 50 states
- U.S. households are randomly selected with a known,non-zero probability from the NORC National Frame as well as address based sample (ABS) frames

### LINGUISTICALLY AND CULTURALLY SKILLED OUTREACH

- 92% of households offered a language in which they are comfortable
- Design recruitment and surveys to maximize engagement



#### **OVERALL ASSESSMENTS OF THE UNITED STATES**

- Only **12%** say democracy in the US **is working well**.
- 81% of AAPIs believe the country is going in the wrong direction.
  - Wrong direction assessments are particularly high among AAPI Republicans,
     Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders, Korean Americans, and people born in the United States

### **POLITICAL BELIEFS**

- **52% of AAPIs identify as Democrats**, 27% identify as Republican, and 21% identify as independent or having no party affiliation.
- **45% of AAPIs approve of President Biden**, which is higher than the general public at 38%.
- **54% of AAPIs disapprove of Biden**, which is lower than the general public at 61%.
  - Biden approval is particularly low among Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders (**only 22%**).



#### VIEWS ON DEMOCRACY

- 83% of AAPIs have concerns about misinformation in the U.S. election, surpassing concerns about voter suppression (46%), limitations on free speech (41%), and voter fraud (31%).
- Concerns about **misinformation** are particularly high among **Filipino and Korean Americans** 
  - Concerns are high among **Democrats and Republicans alike**
- Concerns about **voter suppression** are especially high among AAPI women; Japanese Americans and Filipino Americans.
  - Concern is very high among AAPI Democrats (53% say it's a major problem), but AAPI
     Republicans are also concerned (41%, compared to only 30% of Republicans generally).
- Concerns about **free speech** are especially high among NHPIs, Japanese and Korean Americans.
  - Concern is higher among **AAPI Republicans** than AAPI Democrats
- Concerns about **voter fraud** are higher among NHPIs, AAPI Republicans, and AAPIs 60 and older.



### VIEWS ABOUT PARTY ADVANTAGE BY ISSUE

- AAPIs rate the **Republican Party** slightly higher on **handling the economy**, and **Democrats** much higher on student debt and climate change.
  - AAPIs rate Democrats and Republicans about equally on immigration
  - On **democracy-related matters**, AAPIs rate Democrats much higher than Republicans
- On **handling the economy**, the Republican Party holds the strongest advantage among Korean Americans, foreign-born adults, and males
  - The Republican Party's advantage is non-existent among Asian Indians, women, young adults
- On **handling climate change**, the Democratic Party holds the strongest advantage among Indian Americans, those ages 18 to 29, and those who speak English at home
- On **handling student debt**, the Democratic Party holds the strongest advantage among Indian Americans, those ages 18 to 29, and those who speak English at home



### PARTISANSHIP, ETHNICITY, AND AGE EMERGE AS KEY FACTORS

- Partisanship is the strongest predictor of divisions in AAPI opinion
  - Divisions are very strong with respect to views on direction of the country and concerns about voter fraud and suppression of free speech
  - Divisions are not as strong on concerns about voter suppression and misinformation
- **Ethnicity** matters on several topics, but is not as strong nor as consistent across the board
  - Indian Americans tend to rate the Democratic Party higher on a range of issues
  - Japanese and Filipino Americans show strongest concerns about voter suppression
  - Filipinos show strongest concern on misinformation, while Japanese Americans show strongest concern about suppression of free speech
- Divisions by **age** also emerge on matters of public opinion, but are not always consistent
  - 38% of those age 18-29 reporting they trust neither party to handle the economy
  - Democrats hold a stronger advantage among 18-29 year olds on student debt and climate change
  - Related to age, nativity also matters on several issues, with native-born AAPIs more progressive on a range of issues




## **Direction of this country**

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



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





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





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


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How much of a problem is people who are eligible not being allowed to vote? by Nativity, Language, and Gender

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








#### How much of a problem are efforts to limit free speech? by Party ID and Age



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





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



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


